

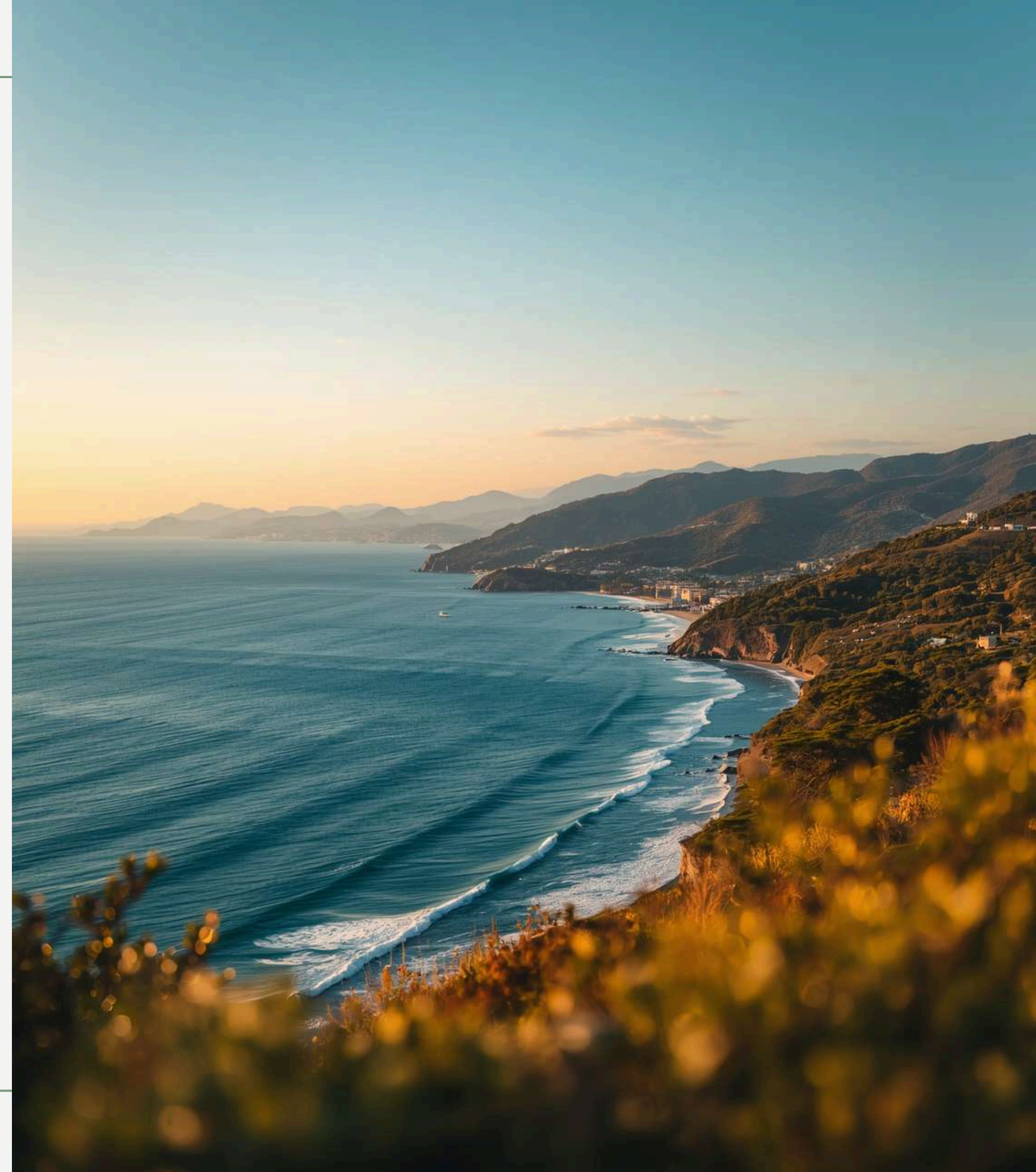

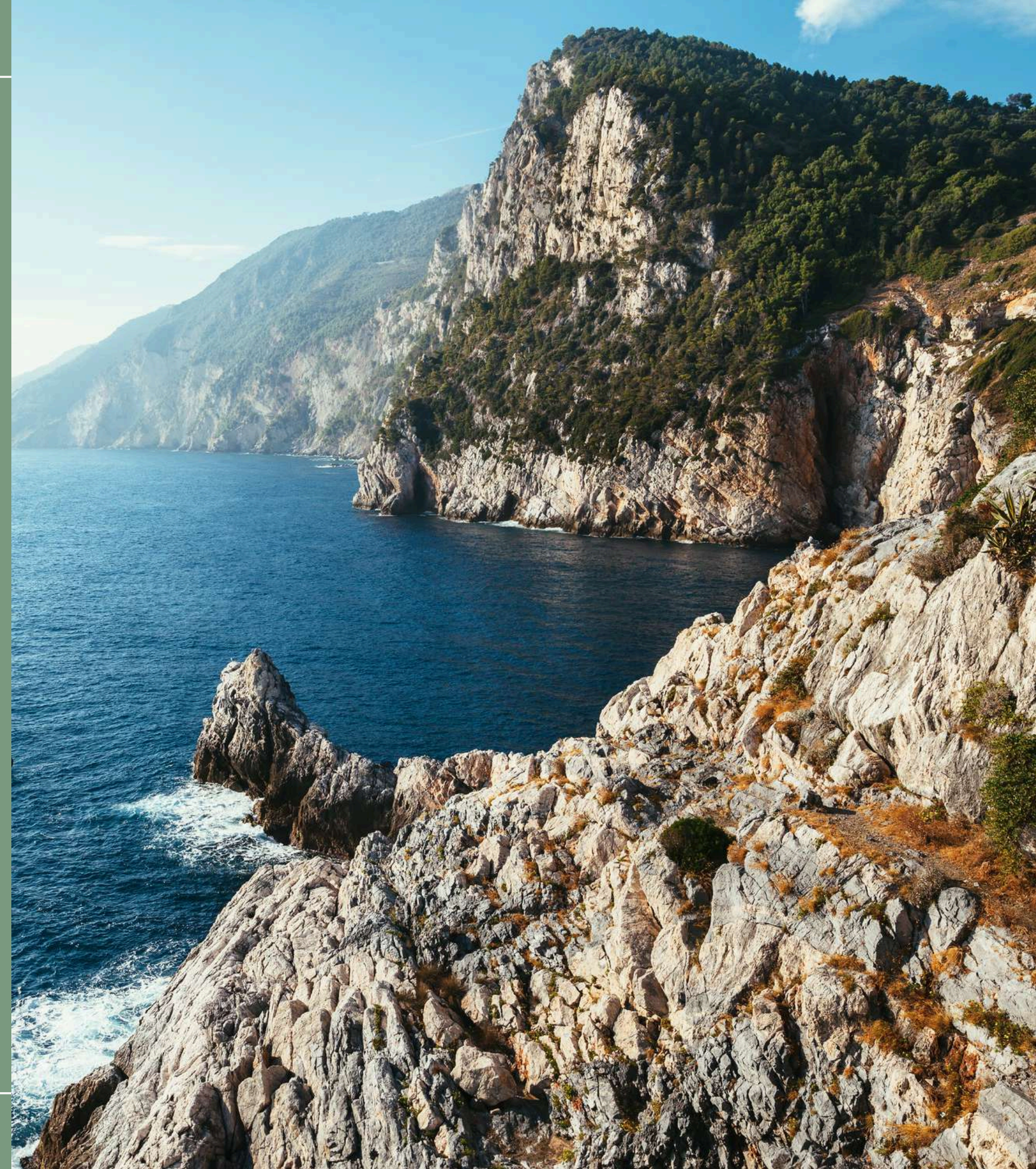


# A surprising nature

**The Genoa Aquarium** represents an important point of reference for awareness and conservation, allowing visitors to experience firsthand the complexity and value of marine environments.



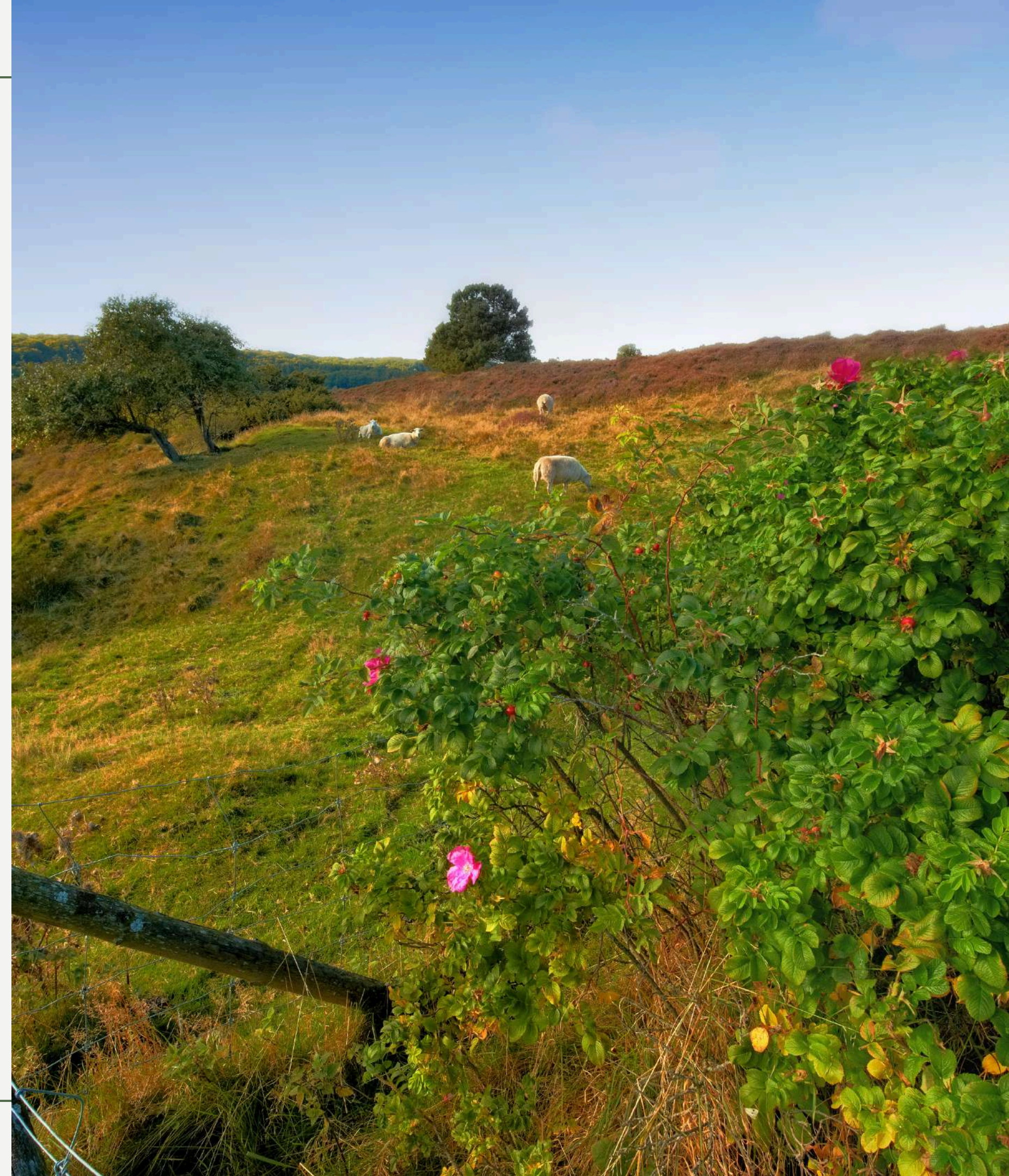
# Natural areas to discover
